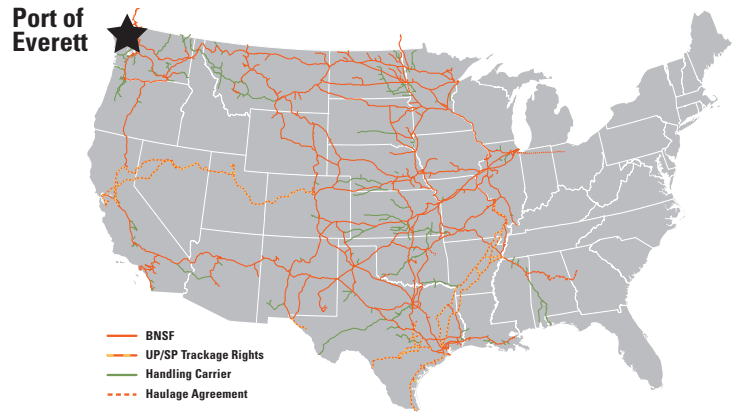


Port of Everett

The Port of Everett, located just 25 miles north of Seattle, Washington, is a natural deep-water port that plays a critical role in the regional transportation network. The Port specializes in handling conventional and over dimensional cargoes for the construction, manufacturing, aerospace, military, energy, agriculture, and forest products industries. A large percentage of the Port's containerized cargo is tied to the local aerospace industry. Everett's seaport accommodates oversized, ocean-going aerospace parts and other airplane program components. The Port of Everett is designated one of only 18 Strategic Commercial Seaports nationwide by MARAD.



TERMINAL CAPABILITIES

- **Harbor:** One
- **Berths:** Eight, equaling 5,745 ft.
- **Cranes:**
 - Five ship-to-shore
 - Two mobile cranes with lifting capacity of 100MT and 150MT
- **Depth:** 40 ft. at Mean Lower Low Water (MLLW)
- **Rail-Served:** 12,500 lineal feet of rail trackage
 - Direct access to BNSF mainline
 - 110-ton rail-loading ramp
- **Cargo Handled:**

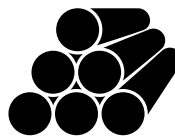
